FACTS ABOUT VETERAN HOMELESSNESS:

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), along with the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) and the U.S. Interagency Council on Homelessness (USICH), released initial results from HUD's 2022 Point-in-Time (PIT) count. The data points to an 11% decline in homelessness among veterans between 2020 and 2022, the largest drop in homelessness for veterans in more than five years. *Statistics from The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development November 3, 2022*

Community support of programs like Reach Veteran Services allows us to address the needs of local Veterans and further the mission of ending Veteran Homelessness.

FACTS ABOUT YOUR COMMUNITY:

The regional summer count conducted in July 2022 observed 531 <u>sheltered and unsheltered</u> homeless individuals in Vigo County. We know that typically 30% of those experiencing homelessness are Veterans, so out of the 6,942 Veterans in Vigo County, approximately 160 of them are homeless.
